The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on April 24, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Tony Wallingsford. Invocation was given by Council Member Gary Stewart. Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Patrick Stewart. The roll was called by the City Clerk Whitney Phillips with the following results:

**CONSIDER ORDINANCE 594: AMEND SALES TAX  
HOLIDAY**

**ORDINANCE 594**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama that Ordinance No. 570, adopted on the 11<sup>th</sup> of June, 2012 is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

**SECTION 1:** In conformity with the provisions of Code of Alabama 175 Section 11-51-210(e) enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alabama during the 2006 Regular Session, providing for a state sale tax holiday, the City of Scottsboro, Alabama, exempts covered items” from the municipal sales and use tax during the period, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on Friday of the third full weekend in July ( July 21, 2017) and ending at 12:00 midnight on Sunday of the third full weekend in July ( July 23, 2017).

**SECTION 2:** This ordinance shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods and rules as provided by Code of Alabama 175 Section 11-51-210(e) **each year thereafter until rescinded.**

**SECTION 3:** The City Clerk of the City of Scottsboro is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance under the Seal of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama, and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.

**SECTION 4:** This ordinance shall become effective upon its due passage and publication.
