

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS
CITY OF SCOTTSBORO
OF JACKSON COUNTY, ALABAMA

SEALED BIDS WILL BE RECEIVED BY THE CITY OF SCOTTSBORO AT SCOTTSBORO CITY HALL, 316 SOUTH BROAD STREET, SCOTTSBORO, ALABAMA, 35768 UNTIL TUESDAY, MARCH 31, 2021 AT 2:00 PM AND AT THAT TIME PUBLICLY OPENED FOR THE RESURFACING OF MULTIPLE CITY STREETS:

COLLEGE STREET, KYLE STREET, GARLAND FERRY ROAD, BYNUM AVENUE

THE PRINCIPAL ITEMS OF WORK ARE APPROXIMATELY AS FOLLOWS:

PLANING EXISTING PAVEMENT, SUPERPAVE BITUMINOUS CONCRETE UPPER BINDER PATCHING AND WEARING SURFACE LAYER

TIME PERIODS FOR EACH PROJECT:

THE PROJECT MUST BE COMPLETED WITHIN 40 WORKING DAYS.

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR CONSIDERATION, BIDS MUST BE SUBMITTED ON COMPLETE ORIGINAL PROPOSALS MADE AVAILABLE BY THE OWNER. BID DOCUMENTS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE SCOTTSBORO CITY ENGINEERING OFFICE LOCATED AT 316 SOUTH BROAD STREET, SCOTTSBORO, ALABAMA 35768. NO BID DOCUMENTS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED LATER THAN 24 HOURS PRIOR TO THE SCHEDULED OPENING OF BIDS.

A CASHIER'S CHECK (DRAWN ON AN ALABAMA BANK) OR BID BOND FOR 5% OF THE AMOUNT BID (MAXIMUM OF \$10,000.00) AND MADE PAYABLE TO THE CITY OF SCOTTSBORO, MUST ACCOMPANY EACH BID AS EVIDENCE OF GOOD FAITH.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 34-8-8, CODE OF ALABAMA AS AMENDED, "ALL OWNERS, ARCHITECTS, AND ENGINEERS RECEIVING BIDS PURSUANT TO THIS CHAPTER SHALL REQUIRE THE PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION TO INCLUDE HIS OR HER CURRENT LICENSE NUMBER ON THE BID." IT ALSO STATES THAT "IT WILL BE NECESSARY FOR HIM OR HER TO SHOW EVIDENCE OF LICENSE BEFORE HIS OR HER BID IS CONSIDERED."

PROOF OF INSURANCE COVERAGES OF THE TYPES AND AMOUNTS AS SET FORTH IN THE PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS WILL BE REQUIRED OF THE CONTRACTOR, AND ANY AND ALL SUBCONTRACTORS, PRIOR TO BEGINNING WORK. THE CONTRACTOR WILL BE REQUIRED TO PERFORM WORK AMOUNTING TO AT LEAST 30% OF THE TOTAL CONTRACT COST WITH HIS OWN ORGANIZATION.

THE ATTENTION OF BIDDERS IS CALLED TO THE PROVISIONS OF STATE LAW GOVERNING GENERAL CONTRACTORS, AS SET FORTH IN SECTIONS 34-8-1 TO 43-8-24, INCLUSIVE, CODE OF ALABAMA OF 1975, AS AMENDED; AND THE PROVISIONS OF SAID LAW SHALL GOVERN BIDDERS INsofar AS IT IS APPLICABLE.

THE ABOVE MENTIONED PROVISIONS OF THE CODE MAKE IT ILLEGAL FOR THE OWNER TO CONSIDER A BID FROM ANYONE WHO IS NOT PROPERLY LICENSED UNDER SUCH PROVISIONS. THE OWNER WILL NOT ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH A FOREIGN CORPORATION WHICH IS NOT QUALIFIED UNDER STATE LAW TO DO BUSINESS IN THE STATE OF ALABAMA.

THE PROPOSED WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED IN CONFORMITY WITH ALL APPLICABLE LAWS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS.

BIDDERS MUST COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE BEASON-HAMMON ALABAMA TAXPAYER AND CITIZEN PROTECTION ACT, H.B. 56. THE PROPOSED WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED IN CONFORMITY WITH ALL APPLICABLE LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS. THE RIGHT TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS AND TO DISREGARD ANY MINOR IRREGULARITIES IS RESERVED BY THE OWNER.
