The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on November 14, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Tony Wallingsford. Formalities were given at the preceding Work Session. The roll was called by the City Clerk Whitney Phillips with the following results:

## **CONSIDER RESOLUTION 2016-11-41: SURPLUS POLICE DEPARTMENT PROPERTY**

### **RESOLUTION 2016-11-41**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Scottsboro, Alabama's Fire and Police Departments have certain items of personal property which are no longer needed for public or municipal purposes: and,

**WHEREAS**, Section 11-43-56 of the Alabama Code of 1975 authorizes the municipal governing body to dispose of unneeded personal property;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Scottsboro, Alabama as follows:

**Section 1.** That the following personal property owned by the City of Scottsboro, Alabama is not needed for public or municipal purposes:

Analog Radio System (see attached)

**Section 2.** That the Mayor and City Clerk and they hereby are, authorized and directed to dispose of the property owned by the City of Scottsboro described in Section 1, above, by conveyance to the Jackson County Sheriff's Department.
