The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on November 28, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Tony Wallingsford. Invocation was given by Council Member Gary Stewart. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Patrick Stewart. The roll was called by the City Clerk Whitney Phillips with the following results:
