AUGUST 14, 2017**

The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on August 14, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Tony Wallingsford. Invocation was given by Council Member Gary Stewart. Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Patrick Stewart. The roll was called by the City Clerk Whitney Phillips with the following results:
