The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on July 8, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Patrick Stewart. Invocation given by Council Attorney Stephen Kennamer. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Greg Mashburn. The roll was called by the City Clerk Whitney Phillips with the following results:

Streets to be paved include Parks Avenue, Garden Drive, Gant Road, Snodgrass Road, County Road 33, West Camille Street, Goosepond Parking Lot, Industrial Park/TVA, industrial access at Lequire Drive. Motion was made by Council Member Richard Bailey and seconded by Council Member Greg Mashburn. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.
