The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on August 3, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Patrick Stewart. Formalities were given at the preceding Work Session. The roll was called by the City Clerk Whitney Phillips with the following results:

**CONSIDER ORDINANCE 614: PROHIBITING COMMERCIAL  
VEHICLES ON CERTAIN CITY STREETS**

STATE OF ALABAMA )  
JACKSON COUNTY )

**ORDINANCE NO.: 614**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Scottsboro, in the State of Alabama, as follows:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful and constitute an offense against the City of Scottsboro for any person to operate or remain in a commercial vehicle with a manufactured gross vehicle weight of 10,000 pounds or more, on the following city streets.

"See Exhibit A"

Section 2. Exceptions:

1. Authorized Emergency vehicles, utility trucks and equipment.
2. Delivery trucks or trucks delivering items or services to residents on the named streets.
3. School Buses.
4. Garbage Trucks and Municipal Road Maintenance Equipment.

Section 3. On a 1st, conviction an offender may be fined up to \$250.00. On a 2nd conviction an offender may be fined up to \$500.00.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its due passage and publication as required by law.

1. Moody Ridge Road- from East Willow Street (on the Southeast) to Dawson Street (on the Northeast)
2. Charlotte Street, King Street, Chapell Street, Hays Street, Peachtree Street, Appletree Street, Pine Street, Cherry Street- each West of their intersection with Broad Street.
3. Garden Drive- in its entirety.

#### **RESOLUTION 2020-08-27 AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, required in the said funding agreement the Public Park and Recreation Board must obtain a written approval from the City Council of the City of Scottsboro, prior to accruing additional debt obligations and;

WHEREAS, the Public Park and Recreation Board of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama, desires to purchase property adjacent to Goosepond;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the Scottsboro, that the City does hereby approve that the Public Park and Recreation Board of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama may accrue additional debt obligation not to exceed \$275,000 under the terms and conditions of the 2014 agreement for this purpose.
