The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met in a continued meeting from Monday, October 5, 2020 on Tuesday, October 13, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Patrick Stewart. Formalities were dispensed. The roll was called by the City Clerk Whitney Phillips with the following results:

NEW BUSINESS

REPORT ON PROVISIONAL BALLOTS

The City Clerk, Whitney Phillips, handed out the tapes for Machines 1, 2, and 3 from the Scottsboro Recreation Precinct and also the machine tape from the absentee election officials. Whitney Phillips also reported that a total of three (3) ballots were made provisional on Tuesday, October 6, 2020 during voting. The Board of Registrars examined the three (3) provisional information and found one (1) ballot could be counted and two (2) could not be counted. The Council opened the one (1) ballot and Attorney Kennamer called out the names of the candidates voted for from the ballot. The City Clerk along with the Council tallied the results.
