The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on November 9, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

**CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR GARBAGE
TRUCKS FOR THE SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment for up to \$90,000 and financing for 3 years for the Side Arm Residential and Front Container Garbage Trucks. Motion was made by Council Member Ralph Dawe and seconded by Council Member Nita Tolliver. Little discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR TRUCKS FOR THE STREET DEPARTMENT

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment for up to \$85,000 for trucks for the Street Department. Motion was made by Council Member Nita Tolliver and seconded by Council Member Gary Stewart. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR UNIFORMS FOR VEHICLE MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to a budget amendment for \$3,000 for uniform rental for the Vehicle Maintenance Department. Motion was made by Council Member Mike Ashburn and seconded by Council Member Gary Stewart. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR TVA INVESTPREP GRANT MATCH

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment for \$14,285 for the City's match for the TVA InvestPrep grant. Motion was made by Council Member Mike Ashburn and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.
