**AND WHEREAS**, the owners of the following noted vacant, deteriorated and dilapidated structures within the City of Scottsboro incorporated limits have shown interest in working with the City of Scottsboro to achieve this goal,

**AND WHEREAS**, said structures are noted to be a source of blight within the City of Scottsboro,

**AND WHEREAS**, grant funding for such demolition type projects is available through the State of Alabama (ADECA) Community Development Block Grant Program,

**AND WHEREAS**, the City of Scottsboro concurs with objectives, needs and program activities proposed therein,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SCOTTSBORO:**

That the City of Scottsboro declares the following structures to be vacant, deteriorated and dilapidated structures within its municipal limits:

301 North Houston Street (Scottsboro Wholesale Building)
