The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on January 25, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

WHEREAS, the City of Scottsboro, Alabama has certain property which are no longer needed for public or municipal purposes: and,

WHEREAS, Section 11-43-56 of the Alabama Code of 1975 authorizes the municipal governing body to dispose of unneeded personal property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Scottsboro, Alabama as follows:

Section 1. That the following real property owned by the City of Scottsboro, Alabama is not needed for public or municipal purposes:

106 Chestnut Street (see attached map)

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Clerk and they hereby are, authorized and directed to dispose of the property owned by the City of Scottsboro described in Section 1, above, by conveying to the Downtown Redevelopment Authority to market and assist with downtown development.
