The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on April 26, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

**CONSIDER ORDINANCE 619: AMENDING FIRST MONDAY
ORDINANCE**

ORDINANCE 619

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 577 DEALING
WITH FIRST MONDAY AND OTHER MATTERS WITH
RESPECT THERETO**

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama as follows:

Section One: Effective immediately all of the City's administration of all First Monday events shall be placed in Main Street, Scottsboro, a not for profit corporation, who shall act as agents of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama for the purposes of First Monday events only.

Section Two: Main Street Scottsboro's Administration of First Monday events shall include but not be limited to permitting vendors, assigning spots, setting fee's, advertising and promoting events.

Section Three: Either the City Council of the City of Scottsboro or the Board of Directors of Main Street, Scottsboro shall have the right to terminate this administration of First Monday events by giving written notice six (6) months in advance of said termination.

Section Four: This ordinance shall become effective immediate upon its due passage, adoption and publication as required by law.

Section Five: Any portion of any Ordinance in conflict herewith is repealed insofar as such conflict may exist with the remainder to remain in full force and effect.

That the Mayor and City Clerk and they hereby are, authorized and directed to dispose of the property owned by the City of Scottsboro described in Section 2, above, by selling to another municipality. All money received from the sale shall be placed back into the Street Department Capital Outlay account.

CONSIDER RESOLUTION 2021-04-10: REGARDING SMALL WIRELESS FACILITIES

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-04-10

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Scottsboro as follows:

WHEREAS, Act 2021-5, Acts of Alabama, addresses, in part, the attachment of small wireless facilities on existing poles and structures and gives direction to authorize wireless providers to collocate, mount, or installed small wireless facilities on existing poles of certain designated agencies or entities, including the rights of ways of City's and Towns.

THEREFORE, to the extent that Act 2021-5, Acts of Alabama, applies to the City of Scottsboro, Alabama or any of its facilities and property, it is hereby RESOLVED by the City that the attachment of small wireless facilities to any pole or other structure or facility of the City or use of rights of ways, shall be governed by the existing rules, regulations and policies of the City. Such Resolution shall be considered to be in compliance with Act 2021-5, Section 11, Acts of Alabama.

The City does further RESOLVE to amend or modify this Resolution together with its rules, regulations and policies to be in full compliance with all applicable federal laws, orders or regulations relating to small wireless facilities as the same are defined and described in Act 2021-5, Acts of Alabama within 90 days from a final non-appealable federal order, rule or regulation relating to small wireless facilities.

**CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR TRUCK FOR
ANIMAL CONTROL**

Council President Richard Bailey then called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from sales tax for up to \$29,000 for a truck for Animal Control. Motion was made by Council Member Mike Ashburn and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. Little discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

**CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR STORM
SHELTERS**

Council President Richard Bailey then called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from sales tax for up to \$3,100 to finish the storm shelters. Motion was made by Council Member Gary Stewart and seconded by Council Member Nita Tolliver. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

**CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR
REIMBURSEMENT FOR SITE CLEANUP ON N. HOUSTON
STREET**

Council President Richard Bailey then called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from sales tax for \$1,685 to reimburse the Jackson County Historical Association for site cleanup on North Houston Street. Motion was made by Council Member Nita Tolliver and seconded by Council Member Mike Ashburn. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

**CONSIDER TEMPORARY PART TIME POSITION AT CITY
HALL**

Council President Richard Bailey then called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from sales tax for up to \$4,000 for a temporary position at City Hall. Motion was made by Council Member Mike Ashburn and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. It was discussed this would be a contract labor position for up to 3 months while the City Clerk is on maternity leave. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

CONSIDER PART TIME SEASONAL EMPLOYEE AT THE SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT

Council President Richard Bailey then called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from sales tax for up to \$4,000 for a part time seasonal employee at the Solid Waste Department. Motion was made by Council Member Nita Tolliver and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. It was discussed this would be a contract labor position for up to 3 months. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

CONSIDER AL B.A.S.S. NATION HIGH SCHOOL FISHING TOURNAMENT CONTRACT

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve the AL B.A.S.S. Nation High School Fishing Tournament Contract. The sponsorship fee of \$4,500 and lodging fees would be paid from the Tourism Grant Fund. Motion was made by Council Member Ralph Dawe and seconded by Council Member Gary Stewart. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

CONSIDER TOURISM GRANT APPLICATION FROM THE SCOTTSBORO JACKSON COUNTY RESCUE SQUAD

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve the tourism grant application from the Scottsboro Jackson County Rescue Squad for \$5,000. Motion was made by Council Member Mike Ashburn and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. Little discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

CONSIDER REQUEST TO PROCEED WITH REZONING OF PROPERTY

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to proceed with a public hearing to rezone property located at 1400 Woods Cove Road. Motion was made by Council Member Ralph Dawe and seconded by Council Member Nita Tolliver. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

MAYORAL RECOMMENDATION FOR POLICE CHIEF

Mayor Jim McCamy recommended Ron Latimer be appointed as Police Chief.

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to appoint Ron Latimer to Police Chief. Motion was made by Council Member Ralph Dawe and seconded by Council Member Mike Ashburn. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.
