The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on May 24, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Richard Bailey. Invocation was given by Mayor Jim McCamy. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Mike Ashburn. The roll was called by the City Clerk Whitney Phillips with the following results:

## **CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR ADEM FEES**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from sales tax for \$1,385 for ADEM fees. Motion was made by Council Member Nita Tolliver and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. Little discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

## **CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR POLICE TRAINING ACCOUNT**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from sales tax for \$16,000 to the Police Training account. Motion was made by Council Member Ralph Dawe and seconded by Council Member Nita Tolliver. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

## **CONSIDER APPROVAL TO PAY FINAL PAYMENT ON HERITAGE CENTER PROJECT**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve to pay \$6,795.03 to Tolar Construction for the final payment on the Heritage Center project. Motion was made by Council Member Gary Stewart and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

## **CONSIDER REQUEST TO PROCEED WITH REZONING OF PROPERTY ON BOB JONES ROAD**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to proceed with rezoning of property on Bob Jones Road. **Item died for lack of motion.**

## **CONSIDER APPROVAL OF ASABFA FISHING TOURNAMENT AGREEMENT FOR 2022**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve the ASABFA Fishing Tournament agreement for 2022. The sponsorship fee and lodging fees will come from the Tourism Grant Fund. Motion was made by Council Member Nita Tolliver and seconded by Council Member Gary Stewart. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

## **EXECUTIVE SESSION**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to enter into Executive Session upon the recommendation from City Attorney Stephen Kennamer pursuant to Section 36-25A-7.1 of the Code of Alabama to discuss the general reputation and character, physical condition,

professional competence, or mental health of an individual. Motion was made by Council Member Gary Stewart and seconded by Council Member Nita Tolliver. It was discussed that it should take no more than 30 minutes. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye. The Council Members, Mayor, and City Attorney entered into Executive Session.

The Council, Mayor, and City Attorney returned from Executive Session. Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to rise from Executive Session. Motion was made by Council Member Mike Ashburn and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye. City Attorney Stephen Kenamer certified that no votes were taken and no decisions made pursuant to the Open Meetings Act.
