The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on June 7, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

ORDINANCE NO. # 621

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE
OF THE CITY OF SCOTTSBORO, ALABAMA**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

SCOTTSBORO, ALABAMA, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The Zoning of the following described lands will be changed from AR (Agricultural District) that hereafter such lands shall be shown and classified by The Zoning Ordinance of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama, and on the official Zoning map forming a part of said Zoning Ordinance as being: R-2 (Medium-Density Residential District).

-Legal Description -

All that part of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 35, Township 4 South, Range 5 East of the Huntsville Meridian, Jackson County, Alabama, lying South of Woods Cove Road and East of Porter Road; said property is bordered to the North by Woods Cove Road, the West by Porter Road, to the South by South line of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter and to the East by the East section line of Section 35, Township 4 South, Range 5 East, located in Jackson County, Alabama.

SECTION TWO: The Zoning Ordinance of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama and the official Zoning Map forming a part of said Zoning Ordinance are hereby altered, amended, changed and modified in accordance with Section One hereof.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its due passage and publication, as required by law.

CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR TRACKHOE FOR SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from sales tax for \$86,500 for a trackhoe for the Solid Waste Department. Motion was made by Council Member Nita Tolliver and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. It was

discussed that this would also need to be put out to bid or purchased from State bid list. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to proceed with the request to rezone property located at 25915 John T. Reid Parkway. Motion was made by Council Member Mike Ashburn and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

**CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR RENOVATIONS
AT CARVER PARK**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from sales tax for \$7,200 for renovations at Carver Park. Motion was made by Council Member Ralph Dawe and seconded by Council Member Mike Ashburn. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR FENCE AT KING CALDWELL PARK

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from sales tax \$7,545.23 for a fence at King Caldwell Park. Motion was made by Council Member Mike Ashburn and seconded by Council Member Nita Tolliver. Little discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

CONSIDER RECOMMENDATION FROM MAYOR FOR RECREATION DIRECTOR APPOINTMENT

Mayor Jim McCamy recommended Donald Wood for the Recreation Director position. Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to appoint Donald Wood as Recreation Director. Motion was made by Council Member Nita Tolliver and seconded by Council Member Mike Ashburn. No discussion. A roll call vote was taken with the following results:

CONSIDER REQUEST TO PROCEED WITH APPLYING FOR ADECA EDA GRANT FOR SEWER EXTENSION AND TRAFFIC SIGNAL FOR THE SHOPS OF SCOTTSBORO

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to proceed with the request to apply for an ADECA EDA grant for the sewer extension and traffic signal for the Shops of Scottsboro. Motion was made by Council Member Mike Ashburn and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. Mayor McCamy discussed this would be a \$500,000 grant and we would need to have a public hearing before applying. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.
