**CONSIDER ORDINANCE 622: AMEND ORDINANCE 614:
PROHIBITING TRUCKS ON CERTAIN STREETS**

ORDINANCE NO.: 622

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Scottsboro, in the State of Alabama, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance 614 entitled “An Ordinance Prohibiting Trucks on Certain Streets” adopted and approved by the City of Scottsboro on the 3rd day of August, 2020 is hereby amended as follows:

- a. “Exhibit A” will be amended to include South Houston Street from Willow Street to King Street. (see attached)

Section 2. The remainder of Ordinance 614 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its due passage and publication as required by law.

2. Charlotte Street, King Street, Chapell Street, Hays Street, Peachtree Street, Appletree Street, Pine Street, Cherry Street- each West of their intersection with Broad Street.
3. Garden Drive- in its entirety.
4. South Houston Street-from Willow Street to King Street

Motion was made by Council Member Mike Ashburn and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

**CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR THE CEMETERY
DEPARTMENT FOR A TRACTOR**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from excess sales tax for \$32,076.92 for a tractor for the Cemetery Department. Motion was made by Council Member Nita Tolliver and seconded by Council Member Gary Stewart. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

**CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR SOLID WASTE
DEPARTMENT FOR A USED COMPACTOR**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from sales tax for up to \$118,626 for a used compactor. Motion was made by Council Member Gary Stewart and seconded by Council Member Nita Tolliver. It was discussed that the compactor at the Street Department was too small. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

SHORELINE PROTECTION AT THE JACKSON COUNTY
COUNCIL ON AGING/SCOTTSBORO SENIOR CENTER**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from sales tax for up to \$5,000 for rip rap shoreline protection at the Jackson County Council on Aging/Scottsboro Senior Center. Motion was made by Council Member Mike Ashburn and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.
