The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on November 22, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

**CONSIDER RESOLUTION 2021-11-44: ALDOT
MAINTENANCE AGREEMENTS FOR TRAFFIC SIGNALS
ON HIGHWAY 72/COUNTY PARK ROAD AND HIGHWAY
72/SCOTTSBORO COMMONS**

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-11-44

WHEREAS, The Alabama Department of Transportation (“ALDOT”) has requested the City of Scottsboro, Alabama to execute a permit (agreement) for the installation, operation, and maintenance of the traffic signal on US Highway 72 (SR-2) at the Scottsboro Commons Driveway, and the upgrade and maintenance of the traffic signal on US Highway 72 (SR-2) and County Park intersection, and

WHEREAS, The City Council has considered the request of the ALDOT to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement to permit the installation and upgrades of the traffic signals as identified hereinabove.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama, at a regular meeting, duly assembled, a quorum being present, as follows:

1. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the permit (Exhibit A) with the Alabama Department of Transportation to permit the following:
 - a. Installation, operation, and maintenance of the traffic signal at the US Highway 72 (SR-2) and Scottsboro Commons Driveway intersection.
 - b. Upgrade and maintenance of the traffic signal at the US Highway 72 (SR-2) and County Park intersection.
2. That the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to execute any documents necessary to permit the construction of the installation and upgrades of the traffic signals provided herein above as required by the Alabama Department of Transportation.
3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama.
