The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on December 22, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Richard Bailey. Invocation was given by Mayor Jim McCamy. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Ralph Dawe. The roll was called by the City Clerk Whitney Phillips with the following results:

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to adopt the agenda as prepared. Motion was made by Council Member Nita Tolliver and was seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. No discussion. Upon vote being taken all voted aye. The Council President declared the agenda adopted.

**CONSIDER RESOLUTION 2021-12-50: SURPLUS FIRE  
DEPARTMENT PROPERTY**

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Scottsboro, Alabama's Fire Department has certain property which is no longer needed for public or municipal purposes: and,

**WHEREAS**, Section 11-43-56 of the Alabama Code of 1975 authorizes the municipal governing body to dispose of unneeded personal property;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Scottsboro, Alabama as follows:

**Section 1.** That the following personal property owned by the City of Scottsboro, Alabama:

11 ladders:

- 3 – 14 ft roof ladders
- 3 – 24 ft extension ladders
- 4 – 10 ft attic ladders
- 1 – 12 ft combination ladder

3 Portable Generators:

- Honda 3500-watt generator
- Generac 4000-watt generator
- Buffalo Tools 200-watt generator

2 Floor buffers:

- Floor Buffer, CFP-1700
- Floor Buffer, Clarke Floor Maintainer Model 1700

**Section 2.** That the Mayor and City Clerk hereby are authorized and directed to dispose of the property described in Section 1, above, if determined by the Fire Chief as not needed for public or municipal purposes, by placing on Gov Deals. All money received from the sale shall be placed back into the Fire Department Capital Outlay account.

IRRIGATION REPAIR**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment for \$1,877 from excess sales tax for the Square irrigation repair. Motion was made by Council Member Mike Ashburn and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

**CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR LANDFILL  
WASTE PUMP HEAT TRACE**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from excess sales tax for \$6,385 for the Landfill waste pump heat trace. Motion was made by Council Member Nita Tolliver and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.
