RESOLUTION 2022-03-08

WHEREAS, The City of Scottsboro, Alabama's Recreation Department is in need of an infield finisher, and.

WHEREAS, Section 41-16-50 through 41-16-63, Code of Alabama 1975 authorizes the municipal governing body to secure sealed bids; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-45-2(c) of the Alabama Code of 1975 authorizes the municipal governing body to accept bids by the adoption of a resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Scottsboro, Alabama as follows:

Section 1. That the City of Scottsboro posted one (1) bid, mailed four (4) bids, and received one (1) bid for the infield finisher.

CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from excess sales tax for \$18,902 for the Fire Department. Motion was made by Council Member Mike Ashburn and seconded by Council Member Gary Stewart. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken, Council Member Ralph Dawe abstained, all other members voted aye.

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to re-appoint Ron Leighton and Gene Greer. Motion was made by Council Member Ralph Dawe and seconded by Council Member Nita Tolliver.
