The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on March 28, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve the Airport Director's salary recommended by the Mayor and a budget amendment from excess sales tax for \$11,394. Motion was made by Council Member Mike Ashburn and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

**CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR MONITORS FOR  
THE SCOTTSBORO GOOSEPOND CIVIC CENTER**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from excess sales tax for \$1,420 for monitors at the civic center. Motion was made by Council Member Nita Tolliver and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

**CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR LIGHTING AT  
BYNUM WALKING TRAIL**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from excess sales tax for \$32,000 for lighting at Bynum Walking Trail. Motion was made by Council Member Gary Stewart and seconded by Council Member Mike Ashburn. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

**CONSIDER APPROVAL OF AGREEMENT WITH THE  
ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION AND  
NATURAL RESOURCES (ADCNR) FOR THE MINK CREEK  
BOAT RAMP EXPANSION (TABLED)**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve the agreement. Council Member Mike Ashburn made a motion to table the item until budget discussions. Motion to table was seconded by Council Member Gary Stewart. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.
