The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on June 13, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Richard Bailey. Invocation was given by City Attorney Stephen Kennamer. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Gary Stewart. The roll was called by the City Clerk Whitney Phillips with the following results:

ALABAMA FOR MAYOR MCCAMY**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment for up to \$5,500 from excess sales tax for Mayor McCamy to attend Leadership Alabama. Motion was made by Council Member Gary Stewart and seconded by Council Member Mike Ashburn. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

DAMAGE REPAIRS**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment for \$12,460 from excess sales tax for property damage repairs. Motion was made by Council Member Nita Tolliver and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve exchanging the rollofts on the buy back program and a budget amendment from excess sales tax for \$59,700. Motion was made by Council Member Nita Tolliver and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to allocate \$10,000 from the tourism grant fund for the 2023 Toyota Series Fishing Tournament. Motion was made by Council Member Gary Stewart and seconded by Council Member Mike Ashburn. Little discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.

**CONSIDER BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR COUNTY PARK
ROAD AND HIGHWAY 72 PROJECT**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment for \$230,167.36 from retained earnings from previous years for the County Park Road and Highway 72 project. Motion was made by Council Member Mike Ashburn and seconded by

Council Member Nita Tolliver. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.
