The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on August 22, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

RESOLUTION: 2022-08-30

WHEREAS, City of Scottsboro acting by and through its City Council proposes to apply for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) - Economic Development Grant to extend Alex Garcia Street to improve access to Whataburger and surrounding businesses.

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Scottsboro, Alabama, as follow:

THAT, JIM MCCAMY, MAYOR, is hereby authorized to execute and submit an application with appropriate assurances to the State of Alabama, Department of Economic and Community Affairs, requesting Fiscal Year 2022 CDBG Economic Development Grant Funds in the amount of **\$200,000.00** to extend Alex Garcia Street to improve access to Whataburger and surrounding businesses.

THAT, THE CITY OF SCOTTSBORO will provide a local match of **\$40,000.00** in support of the construction phase of this project.
