The City Council of the City of Scottsboro, Alabama met on October 24, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. in the Gail J. Duffey Auditorium of the Scottsboro City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Council President Richard Bailey. Invocation was given by Mayor Jim McCamy. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Richard Bailey. The roll was called by the City Clerk Whitney Phillips with the following results:
