**CONSIDER ORDINANCE 646 RELATED TO SLEEPING IN  
PARKED VEHICLES, TENTS, OR MAKESHIFT CAMPS ON  
PRIVATE LOT OF ANOTHER OR ON PUBLIC PROPERTY**

**ORDINANCE NO. 646**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATED TO SLEEPING IN PARKED VEHICLES, TENTS, OR  
MAKESHIFT CAMPS ON PRIVATE LOT OF ANOTHER OR ON PUBLIC PROPERTY  
AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO**

**SECTION ONE:**

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person to sleep in, or use for sleeping or camping quarters, any automobile or any other vehicle, while vehicle is parked on any street or other public roadway or public land, except this provision shall not prohibit sleeping or camping in recreational vehicles on public land officially established as a trailer camp, tent camp, or tourist camp and designed for overnight sleeping or camping.
- B. It shall be unlawful for any person to sleep in, or use as sleeping quarters in, or camping in, any public place, public house, building or structure within the city unless such building or structure is one which has been approved and provided with beds or sleeping quarters and bathroom facilities.
- C. It shall be unlawful for any person to sleep in or camp upon, or use as sleeping quarters, or camping in any private lot or grounds or public property or grounds, whether such sleeping, or camping, is had or done in any vehicle or camp located upon a private lot or land or public property without the written consent of the land owner of such private lot or land, or in the case of public property, the person must have written consent of authorized public official of the City of Scottsboro.
- D. Violation of this Ordinance shall be an offense against the City of Scottsboro punishable by a fine of up to \$250.00 for the first offense, and \$500.00 for the second offense and thereafter.

**SECTION TWO:** This Ordinance shall become effective on its due passage and publication as required by law.

**CONSIDER ORDINANCE 647 FURTHER AMENDING  
SCOTTSBORO'S MUNICIPAL GARBAGE DISPOSAL  
ORDINANCE**

**AN ORDINANCE FURTHER AMENDING  
SCOTTSBORO'S MUNICIPAL GARBAGE DISPOSAL  
ORDINANCE AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING  
THERE TO.**

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Scottsboro, as follows:

**Section One:** Scottsboro's Municipal Garbage Disposal Ordinance adopted on, to wit, April 9, 1956, as amended shall be and the same hereby is further amended as follows:

- a. The monthly charges imposed by the City of Scottsboro for the collection, handling and disposal of garbage for residence is fixed at \$16.79 per month for one (1) 100 gallon container for weekly pick up and \$25.19 for two (2) 100 gallon container pick up.
  
- b. Roll off charges imposed by the City of Scottsboro are fixed as follows:
  - 1. 20 yard roll off  
Rental \$60.00 per month with a pull fee of \$200.00 Deposit is fixed at \$300.00
  
  - 2. 30 yard roll off  
Rental \$90.00 per month with a pull fee of \$295.00. Deposit is fixed at \$300.00.
  
  - 3. 40 yard roll off.  
Rental \$125.00 per month with a pull fee of \$325.00.
  
- c. Compactor Rates.  
\$10.00 per yard with a pull fee of \$125.00.
  
- d. The monthly charges for collection, handling and disposing garbage for a business or commercial establishments are hereby fixed as follows:

(1) 100 gallon container:

One pickup per week	<u>\$25.19</u>
Two pickups per week	<u>\$38.63</u>
Three pickups per week	<u>\$55.39</u>
Four pickups per week	<u>\$72.23</u>
Five pickups per week	<u>\$90.70</u>

(2) 4 yd containers:

One pickup per week	<u>\$94.06</u>
Two pickups per week	<u>\$173.00</u>
Three pickups per week	<u>\$253.62</u>
Four pickups per week	<u>\$329.21</u>
Five pickups per week	<u>\$404.78</u>
Six pickups per week	<u>\$480.36</u>

(3) 8 yd containers:

One pickup per week	<u>\$131.01</u>
Two pickups per week	<u>\$243.54</u>
Three pickups per week	<u>\$356.07</u>
Four pickups per week	<u>\$465.24</u>
Five pickups per week	<u>\$574.42</u>
Six pickups per week	<u>\$680.23</u>

(4) 300 gallon containers:

One pickup per week	<u>\$45.35</u>
Two pickups per week	<u>\$63.83</u>
Three pickups per week	<u>\$92.38</u>
Four pickups per week	<u>\$120.94</u>
Five pickups per week	<u>\$149.48</u>

- e. Disposal Fee's at Landfill
  - Inert/Construction Debris, \$38.60
  - pt Sanitation Debris \$49.95 pt,
  - With a \$20.00 minimum fee

**Section Two:** All monthly charges imposed by the City of Scottsboro for the collecting, handling and disposal of garbage for businesses, commercial establishments and residences established herein shall be considered a base amount. Monthly charges for any of the above collection, hauling, handling or disposal of garbage shall increase 3% on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, 2024, and shall be increased an additional 3% on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October for each year thereafter for a period of 15 years.

**Section Three:** This Ordinance shall be effective for residential, business and commercial customers effective the billing cycle of October, 2024 and shall be effective for roll off and compactors customers effective on its due passage and publication as required by law.

**Section Four:** All other provisions of the aforesaid Municipal Garbage Ordinance, as amended, which are not in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

THE CEMETERY DEPARTMENT**

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve a budget amendment from excess sales tax for \$20,530.66 for mowers for the Cemetery Department. Motion was made by Council Member Nita Tolliver and seconded by Council Member Ralph Dawe. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.
