**WHEREAS**, Section 11-45-2(c) of the Alabama Code of 1975 authorizes the municipal governing body to accept bids by the adoption of a resolution;

Council President Richard Bailey called for a motion to approve allocating \$125,000 from ARPA funds for the Mink Creek Boat Launch Expansion. Motion was made by Council Member Nita Tolliver and seconded by Council Member Donna Fredrick. No discussion. Upon a vote being taken all members voted aye.
